

SLAS2013 QUICK REFERENCE: 'GETTING THERE'

Getting to the venue

To get from the airport to University we'd advise you to take the train (frequent 24-hour service, 30 mins to Piccadilly and Oxford Road stations); then bus from there to the University on Oxford Road. Alternatively a taxi will cost about £20.

Trains from Birmingham and London arrive at Piccadilly station. Leave the station at the downstairs Fairfield St exit and catch the 147 bus from stop D to the University. This service runs every ten minutes from 7.15am to 9pm, weekdays, and costs 80p single.

Car parking

The multi-storey car parks at both Booth Street West offers paid public parking and are convenient and safe. There is also Booth Street East, nearest our venue, which is also open to public.

If you need to print your finished paper, this can be done as a last resort at our reception desk. Please show restraint in your use of this service, and only print for your own use, and not for distribution to those attending panels. If colleagues wish to have a copy of your paper, please email them a digital version.

If you're online use the search box atop the [SLAS2013 site](#) to locate references to particular people or topics - this is one way of tracking down panels of interest, and might be easier than leafing through the book of abstracts. Or use the search facility on the Author page to locate the panels of specific colleagues. Or simply use the list at the back of the book.

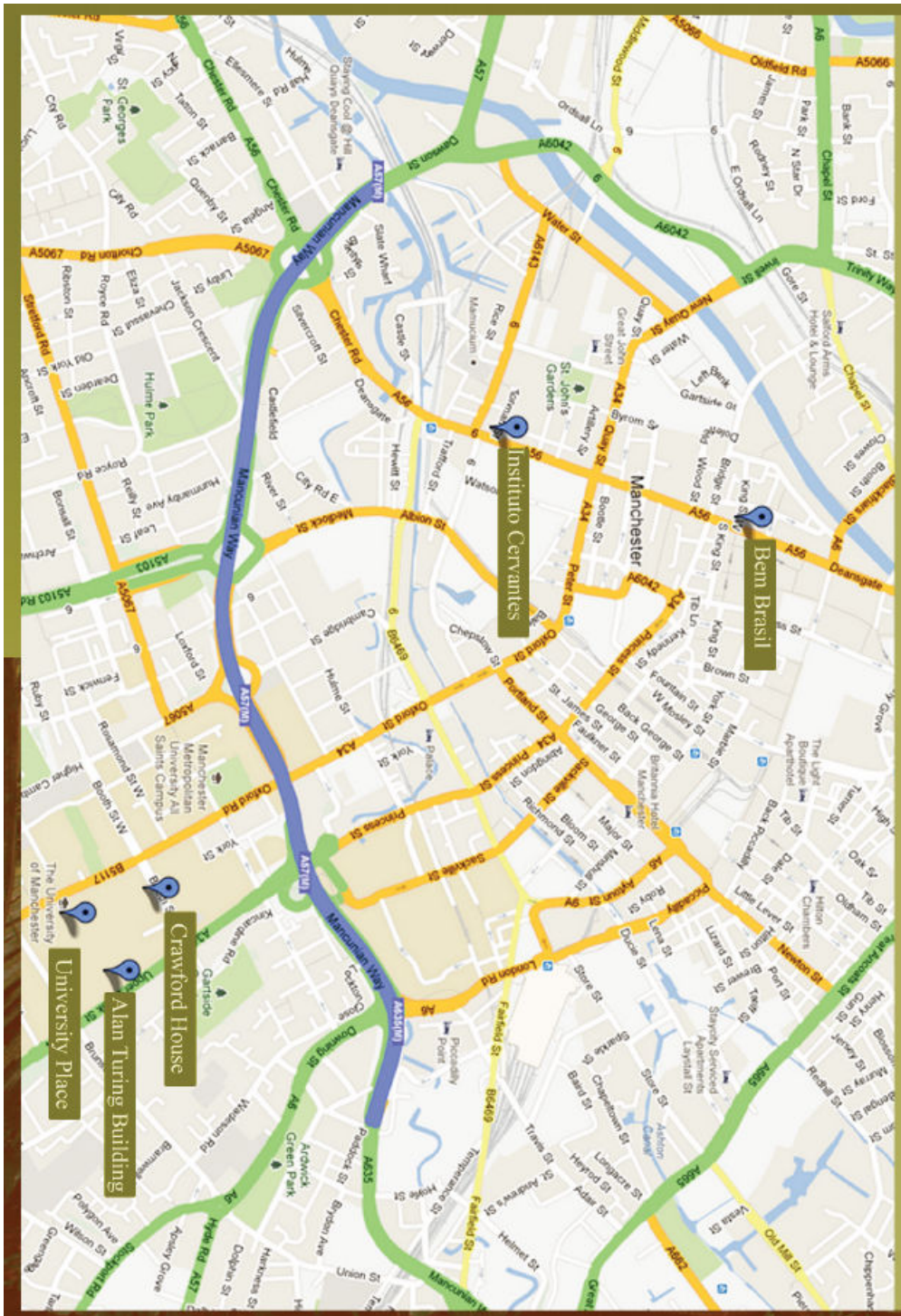
Emergency contact details
